**IN RE: HB1243** by Thompson (Relating to compensation of insurance agents by small employer health benefit plan carriers.), **As Introduced**

The Department of Insurance would receive complaints from agents alleging violations of prohibited compensation-related practices and develop new rules. According to the agency, any costs could be absorbed within current resources.
