**IN RE: HB1252** by Hope (Relating to the selection of a jury in criminal and civil cases. ),

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would authorize the court's designee to discharge a prospective juror or postpone the prospective juror's service. The bill would take effect September 1, 2003 and would apply only to persons summoned to appear for jury service on or after that date.
