IN RE: HB1257 by Allen (Relating to laws regulating the carrying of weapons and the places where weapons are prohibited and to the organization of those laws in the statutes.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the sections of the Penal Code related to laws regulating the carrying of weapons and the places where weapons are prohibited. The Texas Department of Criminal Justice and the Texas Department of Public Safety anticipate no fiscal impact from this bill.
