**IN RE: HB1342** by Goolsby (Relating to the authority of the Public Utility Commission of Texas or the Railroad Commission of Texas to conduct a closed meeting to deliberate a security threat, disaster, or energy emergency.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill amends Subchapter D, Chapter 551, Government Code to add Section 551.093 to permit the Public Utility Commission and the Railroad Commission to conduct closed meetings to deliberate implementation plans for responding to a security threat, disaster, or energy emergency.
