IN RE: HB1398 by Swinford (Relating to procedures for arbitration of seed performance disputes.),
As Engrossed

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill specifies that if a purchaser of seed submits a claim to arbitration based on seed defects, the purchaser must submit the claim no later than 10 days after the date the defects were discovered.

Local Government Impact
