IN RE: HB1401 by Goolsby (Relating to the implementation of Amber Alert or another system for publicly disseminating emergency information about abducted children by the Texas Lottery Commission.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code by requiring the Texas Lottery Commission to implement Amber Alert notifications concerning abducted children to the public through its retailers.
