**IN RE: HB1401** by Goolsby (Relating to the implementation of Amber Alert or another system for publicly disseminating emergency information about abducted children by the Texas Lottery Commission.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code by requiring the Texas Lottery Commission to implement Amber Alert notifications concerning abducted children to the public through its retailers.
