**IN RE: HB1440** by Eissler (Relating to the frequency of public school teacher appraisals.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

Current law requires that each teacher be appraised annually. This bill would authorize a school district to appraise a teacher on a less frequent basis if the teacher agrees in writing and the teacher's most recent evaluation was satisfactory and did not identify any area of deficiency.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
