**IN RE: HB1577** by Gallego (Relating to the prohibition of glass containers within the boundaries of a state-owned riverbed; providing criminal penalties.), **As Engrossed** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would prohibit glass containers within state-owned riverbeds. Costs to enforce this provision are expected to be absorbed within existing agency resources.

## **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. Local governmental entities would realize minimal revenue from the new misdemeanor fines.
