IN RE: HB1609 by Riddle (Relating to administration of certain oaths by an employee of a personal bond office.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Section 602.003, Government Code, to add to the situations in which an employee of a personal bond office would be authorized to administer an oath. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2003.

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
