IN RE: HB1654 by Wohlgemuth (Relating to designation of a portion of State Highway 121 in Tarrant and Johnson counties as the Chisolm Trail Parkway.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to designate State Highway 121 between Farm-to-Market Road 1187 in Tarrant County and United States Highway 67 in Johnson County as the Chisolm Trail Parkway. The bill would require the Texas Department of Transportation to design, construct, and erect a marker at each end of the highway and at appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

Based on the analysis of the Texas Department of Transportation, it is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

The bill would take effect immediately upon receiving a two-thirds majority vote in both houses; otherwise, the bill would take effect September 1, 2003.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
