**IN RE: HB1669** by Allen (Relating to contracts between the Texas Board of Criminal Justice and commissioners courts or private vendors for certain facilities.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Government Code to repeal Section 495.007 which limits the board of the Department of Criminal Justice to contracting for a maximum of 4,580 beds. It is assumed that the bill would not significantly affect the operations of state government.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
