**IN RE: HB1719** by Goodman (Relating to allowing a governmental body to conduct a self-evaluation of the governmental body's performance in a closed meeting.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

Under the bill a governmental body would not be required to conduct a open meeting to engage in a self-evaluation of the governmental body's performance as a whole or to deliberate on the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of one or more public officers or of a public employee.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
