**IN RE: HB1791** by Chisum (Relating to permits for the commercial composting of certain solid wastes.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would prohibit the commercial composting of grease trap waste unless a person has obtained a permit from the Commission on Environmental Quality.
