IN RE: HB1791 by Chisum (Relating to permits for the commercial composting of certain solid wastes.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would prohibit the commercial composting of grease trap waste unless a person has obtained a permit from the Commission on Environmental Quality.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
