IN RE: HB1859 by Bohac (Relating to the construction or operation of chemical dependency treatment facilities near certain residential and community properties.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would limit the location where certain treatment facilities may be constructed or operated. The governing body of the municipality in which a facility is proposed would be required to hold a hearing to determine if the facility would be within the boundary limit of 1,000 feet from an affected property and must issue a resolution of consent before the facility may be established at the proposed location. The bill would take effect September 1, 2003 and would apply only to construction or operation of a treatment facility that begins on or after December 1, 2003.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
