**IN RE: HB1971** by Uresti (Relating to convictions barring employment in certain facilities serving the elderly or persons with disabilities.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to add specificity to the current law regarding criminal convictions that would bar an individual from employment for five years in certain facilities serving the elderly or persons with disabilities.
