**IN RE: HB2153** by Denny (Relating to filing a voting system equipment contract with the secretary of state.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill amends the Election Code by requiring a contract for voting system equipment be submitted to the Secretary of State for approval.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. Local governmental entities would incur minimal delivery costs to submit the voting system contracts to the Secretary of State's Office.
