**IN RE: HB2237** by Kuempel (Relating to the financial assistance for the eligible survivor of a member of an organized volunteer fire-fighting unit. ), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

If enacted, the provisions of the bill are not expected to have a significant fiscal impact on the public safety worker benefits program administered by the Employees Retirement System (ERS); however, ERS is unable to determine how many additional persons would qualify for the death benefits.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
