IN RE: HB2283 by Brown, Betty (Relating to development regulations for certain unincorporated areas located in the watersheds of Cedar Creek Lake, the Trinity River, and the East Fork of the Trinity River; providing a penalty.), **As Introduced**

The bill would authorize the commissioners court of Kaufman County to regulate certain development related to the unincorporated areas located in the watersheds of Cedar Creek Lake, the Trinity River, and the East Fork of the Trinity River.
