IN RE: HB2429 by Brown, Fred (Relating to construction standards for certain assisted living facilities.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Health and Safety Code, Chapter 247, section 247.030(b) to require those facilities classified by the Board of Human Services as converting to "a large Type B facility" to conform to National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 101 standards that the Department of Human Services designates for assisted living facilities.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
