IN RE: HB2538 by Uresti (Relating to activity of a criminal street gang that constitutes a public nuisance.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend various sections of the Civil Practice and Remedies Code that relate to public nuisances. The Office of Court Administration indicates that passage of the bill would not have a fiscal impact to the state.
