IN RE: HB2548 by King (Relating to the authority of the Public Utility Commission of Texas to order construction of electric transmission capacity.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Utilities Code to expand the Public Utility Commission's authority regarding electric transmission capacity. Based on the analysis by the Public Utility Commission, the provisions of the bill would have no fiscal impact to the state.
