IN RE: HB2576 by Baxter (Relating to renewable energy credit for converting solid waste into electric energy.), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The Public Utility Commission and the Commission on Environmental Quality anticipate that any additional work as a result of the passage of the bill could be reasonably absorbed with current resources.
