**IN RE: HB2662** by Puente (Relating to the authority of a municipality to sell a water or sewer system without an election.), **As Engrossed**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would repeal Section 402.908, Local Government Code. The code that would be repealed authorizes a municipality, without an election, to sell certain water districts a water or sewer system owned by the municipality. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives a two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2003.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
