IN RE: HB2662 by Puente (Relating to the authority of a municipality to sell a water or sewer

system without an election.), As Introduced

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would repeal Section 402.908, Local Government Code. The code that would be repealed authorizes a municipality, without an election, to sell certain water districts a water or sewer system owned by the municipality. The bill would take effect immediately if it receives a two-thirds vote in each house; otherwise, it would take effect September 1, 2003.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
