IN RE: HB2689 by Keffer, Jim (relating to the practice of law.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

The bill would amend the Occupations Code adding an exception to the practice of law relating to persons performing certain transactions involving mineral or mine interests. The bill would take effect September 1, 2003.
