**IN RE: HB2841** by Corte (Relating to the civil liability of certain emergency medical services personnel and providers.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would provide for limited civil liability for emergency services providers that provide 9-1-1 emergency services on behalf of a public agency. The provision should not significantly impact the state budget.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. There may be minimal savings in liability insurance premiums for emergency services providers.
