**IN RE: HB2910** by Gallego (Relating to the state's goal for electrical generation capacity by renewable energy technologies.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill amends the Utilities Code to expand the state's renewable energy goal. The Public Utility Commission indicates that passage of the bill would have a \$134,916 cost to the agency. It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill could be reasonably absorbed with current resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
