IN RE: HB2915 by Wise (Relating to the nonprofit organizations qualified to finance certain guaranteed student loans.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would repeal the September 1, 2003, expiration date for qualified nonprofit corporations to issue student loan bonds under Chapter 53 of the Education Code. The Texas Public Finance Authority states that no fiscal impact to the state is anticipated.
