## No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) estimates implementation of the bill would cost \$329,375 per year in federal funds, based on its current experience with a similar pilot program. It is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing provisions of the bill could be accomplished by TWC utilizing existing resources.

#### **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
