**IN RE: HB3053** by Hughes (Relating to delay in the deregulation of certain electric utilities.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Utilities Code by delaying competition in certain non-ERCOT areas. The Public Utility Commission indicates it could absorb the costs associated with the bill within its current resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
