**IN RE: HJR41** by Rodriguez (Proposing a constitutional amendment to remove restrictions on the types of voting methods that may be used to elect the governing body of a municipality.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated,** other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$85,275.

The resolution proposes a change to the Texas constitution to remove restrictions on the types of voting methods that may be used to elect the governing body of a municipality. If the resolution is passed, it would be presented to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2003.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated. Passage of the resolution itself would not impact units of local government.
