No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$85,275.

The resolution does not contain enabling language and would have no fiscal impact, except the cost of publication. If enabling legislation were enacted, however, there could be a fiscal impact on units of local government.
