**IN RE: HJR85** by Homer (proposing a constitutional amendment to allow wineries in this state to manufacture, sell, and dispense certain wine. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated,** other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$85,275.

The bill would amend the Texas Constitution to allow wineries in the state to sell and dispense certain wine.
