**IN RE: SB82** by Zaffirini (Relating to the priority given to the hearing by trial courts of certain ad valorem tax matters.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would amend Government Code, Chapter 23, relating to a trial court giving preference to certain ad valorem tax matters and other types of cases when setting hearing dates. The bill would take effect September 1, 2003.
