IN RE: SB89 by Wentworth (Relating to compensatory time for persons governing state agencies.),
As Engrossed

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill exempts a member of a governing body of a state agency or a single state officer, who governs a state agency, from accruing compensatory time. The Employee Retirement System indicates that the bill would not have a significant impact.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
