IN RE: SB111 by Barrientos (Relating to a voting student member on the board of regents of The University of Texas System.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Governor to appoint one regent for The University of Texas (UT) System from the student body and delineates the method for the Chancellor of the UT System to submit applicants for gubernatorial appointment.
