**IN RE: SB185** by Janek (Relating to standing water as a nuisance. ), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the definition in the Health and Safety Code, which defines conditions that constitute a public health nuisance. The bill amends the definition of a collection of water as a public health nuisance to include collections of water that are a breeding area for *Culex quinquefasciatus* mosquitoes that can transmit diseases regardless of the collection's location.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
