IN RE: SB216 by Zaffirini (Relating to the disposal by a veterinarian of animal remains and associated medical waste.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would broaden the existing permit exemption for veterinarians to allow the disposal of animal remains and associated medical waste by burial or burning under certain conditions.
