IN RE: SB306 by Carona (Relating to the cremation of human remains and the operation of crematories and certain related entities; providing a penalty.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

The bill would require all crematories operating in Texas to be licensed by the Texas Funeral Service Commission.

It is assumed duties and costs associated with the implementation of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.
