**IN RE: SB501** by Armbrister (Relating to the application of criminal trespass laws to persons licensed to carry a concealed handgun.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Penal Code by providing exceptions to the prosecution of individuals for the offense of criminal trespass, and to the offense of trespass by holder of a license to carry a concealed handgun. Providing exceptions to the prosecution of individuals for offenses would result in fewer prosecutions and would not result in additional fiscal implications to the State.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
