IN RE: SB564 by West (Relating to the application of certain marketing and contracting restrictions to treatment facilities funded by the Texas Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse.), As Engrossed

The bill would add treatment facilities funded by the Texas Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse to the list of exempted entities with which school districts may contract for outpatient services.
