IN RE: SB634 by Gallegos (Relating to appointment of fire protection personnel.), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Government Code, Section 419.032 (c), to require full-time fire protection personnel appointed to fire-based emergency medical duties to complete a fire suppression training course. The bill would take effect September 1, 2003.
