**IN RE: SB840** by Whitmire (Relating to authority of certain peace officers to make arrests outside their jurisdictions. ), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure by expanding the jurisdiction of peace officers to allow arrests for offenses occurring in their presence regardless of where the offense occurs.
