**IN RE: SB864** by Van de Putte (Relating to the promotion of breast-feeding.), **As Engrossed**

The bill would amend Chapter 165 of the Health and Safety Code to authorize a physician licensed to practice in this state to use the designation "breast-feeding friendly" in promotional materials if the physician develops a policy supporting breast-feeding and submits that policy to the Texas Department of Health (TDH). The bill would require TDH to maintain a list of such physicians and to make the list available to the public.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2003.

TDH indicated that the duties associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing staff.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
