**IN RE: SB1073** by West (Relating to convictions barring employment in certain facilities serving the elderly or persons with disabilities.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend Health and Safety Code Section 250.006(b) to provide more specificity about the types of convictions that would bar for five years employment in certain facilities serving the elderly or disabled.
