IN RE: SB1237 by Estes (Relating to additional fees assessed against institutions licensed under Chapter 242, Health and Sasfety Code.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would exempt veterans homes from trustee fund assessments. The Department of Human Services (DHS) indicated that there are 4 veteran's homes each with 160 beds. DHS estimated that with the current trustee fund assessment of \$12 per bed the reduction in revenue accruing to the trustee fund within the Comptroller of Public Accounts would be \$7,680 per year.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
