**IN RE: SB1302** by Madla (Relating to adding land that is in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality to the territory of certain special purpose districts.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would establish procedures required when a political subdivision that supplies fresh water for domestic or commercial use or to furnish sanitary sewer services, roadways, or drainage, seeks to add territory to its jurisdiction if the territory is in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality. The bill would take effect September 1, 2003.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
