IN RE: SB1305 by Lucio (Relating to the treatment of certain private primary or secondary schools as charitable organizations for certain purposes.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would change the definition of a charitable organization to include private primary or secondary schools accredited by the South Association of Colleges and Schools. The bill would take effect September 1, 2003.

Such a change has no identifiable fiscal impact on the state.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
